Berger	Boys' reading club
Betty Layward	
Bridge Academy	Manga club for boys, author visits (for targeted groups), Carnegie shadowing
Brook	EYFS teacher to attend CLPE training (and share with others) to develop young children's confidence/independence as readers/learners. Set of 10 books used with targeted Turkish/Kurdish/Cypriot families.
Cardinal Pole	WBD big event with book fair and author visit. Author/poet workshops. Book club. School magazine and anthology of pupils' work. Reading enjoyment and interest.
Cluster B (Jubilee)	CLPE Power of Reading project in all Cluster B schools (Southwold, Northwold, Harrington, Simon Marks, Springfield, Jubilee, Lubavitch, Tyssen)
Daubeney	Weekly text-related drama work. Dads and lads reading group. Reading packs for boys' home reading. Home learning tasks, inc games.
Gainsborough	Recruiting & training 10+ parent readers to improve engagement/interest in children's learning. Theatre trip at end of term. Book club & bookshop visit for parents.
Gayhurst	Reading club (twice a week), upper KS2 reading with targeted KS1 pupils. Reading workshops/coffee mornings with parents. Children choosing books for lunch club and for 'take home' KS1 books
Grasmere	Dual language books/audio books etc for Turkish speaking children and other new languages (Vietnamese), plus headphones etc and technology to scan for whiteboard enlargement.
Grazebrook	Reading club for targeted children, discussion, online reviews, library display etc. Possible local author visit.
Hackney Free	Whole-school initiative to motivate students to read. Promoting use of library, better range of books. Allocated form time for browsing etc.
Horizon	Multisensory activities for children with severe ASD
Jubilee	After-school reading club for reluctant year 5/6 boys. Aiming to involve parents. (Library visit, treasure hunt, subtitled film, making film).
Kingsmead	Reading buddies Y4,5,6 with Y1,2,3. Comfy outdoor reading area for timetabled buddy sessions. Playground buddies to monitor area.
Lauriston	Lunchtime philosophy club
London Fields	Accelerated reader scheme
Mandeville	Accelerated reader scheme
Millfields	Parents programme - supporting reading & social development. Workshops for parents of nursery/reception children - how to support reading. Professional storytellers to encourage oral storytelling.
Morningside CC	Book borrowing scheme for dads and their babies
Mossbourne	Weekly reading support for lower-ability Y7 learners. Encouraging regular independent reading. Book boxes, reviews, chat etc. Author visit. Library visit. Trip to theatre or exhibition to incorporate into follow-up work.
Nightingale	Parental involvement - EAL reading time with parents invited into class for a dual language session. Storyteller for whole school assembly & workshops.

Shacklewell	Creation of multilingual literacy space with variety of multicultural family resources. Timetabled supported access for families. Reading workshops. Exhibit art/writing from across all cultures in community.
Sir Thomas Abney	Lunchtime/after school reading group for targeted Y5&6 pupils. Involving parents too.
Skinner's	Skills in excellence education days - literacy/reading focus. Specialist intervention for D-C GCSE level students. Adult Literacy & Numeracy course for those who missed a C. New texts for accelerated reader. Workshops. Fancy dress day
Southwold	Y1&2 + family reading. Story sacks, family coffee mornings, storytelling training for parents. Author sessions. Buddying with KS2.
St Dominic's	Reading Corner project. Involving children in redesigning (and then looking after) reading areas. Book bag project for parents.
St John's Education Centre	Reaching Reluctant Readers. 3 guided reading sessions per week in small groups. Fortnightly visits to local library. Extra-curricular activity eg author visit.
St John of Jerusalem	Story sack library for families
St Matthias	Developing library and encouraging children and parents to use it. Dual language books. Author visits, local community visitors. School book day.
Stoke Newington	English/music storytelling project. Developing creativity in English using music - reading stimulating texts to inspire/extend and develop stories, performed with words and music.
Stormont House	Reading buddies with Baden Powell primary school
Tyssen	Working with Hackney Museum to run personal histories project encouraging parents to work with their children
