WHY BECOME A CHILDMINDER OR HOME-BASE CARER?

Being a childminder or home-based carer is a rewarding career which gives you the chance to play an important positive role in a child's development.

What does a childminder do?

A childminder looks after children under the age of 8 in the childminder's own home.

What does a home-based carer do?

A home-based carer looks after children in the children's home.

What is an information session?

Our information sessions are informal meetings where:

- we will explain to you the legal requirements for becoming a registered childminder or home-based carer;
- we will look together at the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) statutory framework;
- we will explain to you what training you need (please note there is a charge for the training);
- we will talk you through the support that is available to you.
