Being a childminder or home-based carer is a rewarding career which gives you the chance to play an important positive role in a child's development.

What does a childminder do?

A childminder looks after children under the age of 8 in the childminder's own home.

What does a home-based carer do?

A home-based carer looks after children in the children's home.

At the information session:

- we will explain the legal requirements for becoming a registered childminder or home-based carer;
- we will look at the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) statutory framework;
- we will explain what training you need;
- we will talk you through the support that is available to you.
