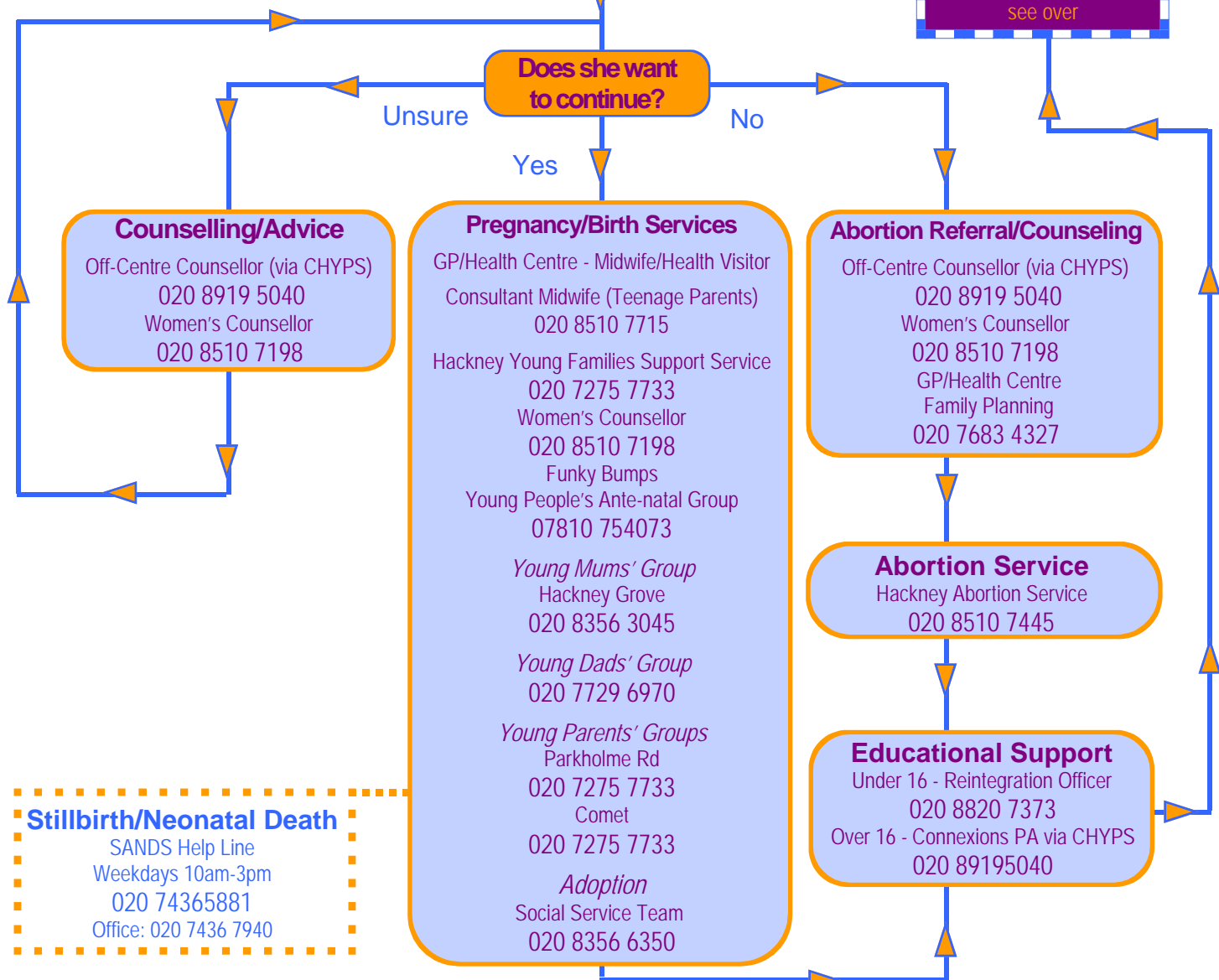

A confidential service for young people under 25, including under 16's. Providing contraception (including the after-sex pill), condoms, pregnancy tests and screening for sexual infections – phone for clinic times, venues and availability of specific services at individual clinics.

For under 21's Tuesdays 4pm-6pm Department of Sexual Health (Homerton Hospital) Testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections. Contraception including emergency contraception. Pregnancy testing and information. Walk-in service. Call for other clinic times

CONDOM DISTRIBUTION SCHEME

Emergency Hormonal Contraceptive Service @ Community Pharmacies

A free and confidential service for young people aged 25 years and under providing emergency hormonal contraception, condoms, signposting to other services and education on sexual health. Available at over 35 local pharmacies displaying the CHYPS logo in their window.

Off-Centre

A free and confidential counseling, advice and information service for young people in Hackney. Provides counseling for pregnant young people and also pre and post-termination counseling.

Teenage Pregnancy Re-integration Officer

Hackney Learning Trust has an Officer supporting school-aged students who are pregnant (or are already parents) with remaining in education - during the pregnancy and after the birth. Also offer support to enable them to make successful transition post-16.

Hackney Young Families Support Service

Providing information on other services that help with housing, health, welfare benefits and education. Providing advice on issues such as; coping with a new baby; dealing with a toddler; difficulties with your own parents; relationship problems; feeling depressed and lonely. Providing practical assistance; applying for welfare benefits; negotiating with colleges or schools; and access interpreting services.

Hackney Abortion Service

Based at the Women's Out-Patients Department at Homerton Hospital providing abortion up to 20 weeks gestation (24 weeks in exceptional circumstances) for clients who live, or are registered with a GP, in City and Hackney. Referral only by a health professional who has confirmed pregnancy and assessed the gestation. Appointment by phone (office hours), or the client can bring the referral letter herself (office hours).

Women's Counsellor

Wed- Fri @ the Homerton Hospital Issues include unplanned pregnancy, pre or post abortion, miscarriage, ante-natal issues, depression around pregnancy and after pregnancy. Self or professional referral.

Floating housing support service for Young Mothers (19-25 yrs) . Support provided with managing their tenancy, childcare, employment etc.

Home-Start Hackney

Home-Start volunteers visit families regularly, in their own homes, usually once a week for a few hours. Sometimes a parent may want someone to discuss their concerns or problems, or even just to share an adult conversation with! At another time they may want practical support such as help to play with the children or to get the family to the shops. Volunteers are not babysitters or home helps so any practical help is given as a friend would.

Newpin Hoxton

A voluntary organisation which helps parents under stress break the cyclical effect of destructive family behaviour. Expectant mothers, parents, carers and children are supported to achieve positive changes in their lives and relationships based on respect, support, equality and empathy. The work focuses on alleviating maternal depression and other mental distress. Newpin works with the main carers of children which means that the majority of user members are women.
