

**Proposal to add a sixth form to
The Urswick School, formerly
Hackney Free and Parochial School**

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the Governing Body of The Urswick School intends to make a prescribed alteration to The Urswick School, Paragon Road, Hackney, London E9 6NR from 01 September 2012.

The Urswick School is a mixed voluntary aided secondary school. The current capacity of the school is 750 and the current admission number for the school is 150. The proposed capacity will be 1050 and the proposed admission number will remain 150.

The proposal includes changing the age range of the school by the addition of a sixth form for 300 pupils from 1 September 2012. The current age range of the school is 11 years to 16 years. The proposed age range will be 11 years to 19 years.

The number of pupils to be admitted to the school at age 16 from 1 September 2012 and subsequent years will be up to 150. In the first year the intention is to admit up to 100 students in year 12, with this number increasing year on year to 150 students by 2015. It is intended to admit students into year 12 in 2012 and into year 13 in 2013
