The LSA/TA will be required to work flexibly taking direction from the class teachers and SENCO in planning and administering the curriculum and following a specialist programme, in these cases for a child needing emotional and behavioural support, specific language difficulties and significant















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special needs.

Candidates must be able to carry out and write up necessary observations to inform and evaluate the child's needs. They must be experienced classroom practitioners proactive in dealing with either Early Years or more challenging older children- state your strength. They must have proven experience and be willing to come in and support the child as part of the interview process.
